Mathematics

- Year I: Addition and subtraction (up • to 20), geometry: shape and place value.
- Year 2: Place value, addition and subtraction, measurement: money and multiplication.
- We place a real emphasis on 'mastery' in maths so that the learning of new concepts is embedded before moving on.
