- In addition to Guided Reading, Phonics and Handwriting lessons, children will be studying:
- Year 1: Stories based on imaginary and fantasy worlds, captions and lists, instructions and poems with pattern and rhyme.
- Year 2: Story by a significant author, instructions and silly stuff/nonsense poems.

Physical Education

- Year 1 will be doing story time dance on Monday afternoons and mighty movers on Tuesdays.
- Year 2 will be swimming on Monday afternoons and multi-skills on Fridays.
