## Response by Year 2 Team

- 3. Through implementing the new curriculum we are learning about concepts in more depth, which the children seem to be enjoying more, as well as becoming more knowledgeable about our concepts. We plan lessons to suit all different learning styles so it is accessible to all children.
- 4. We are encouraging children to understand and reflect on their learning more through the use of learning sails. The children are starting to understand that it is ok to get 'stuck' in their learning and what we can do to help us. We discuss using resources, support from friends and help from adults.
- 5. We encourage the children to challenge themselves within their learning through setting challenges and extensions to learning, which the children are always very proud of when they complete them.
- 6. Feedback is extremely important for the children to progress and in Year 2 the children respond best to verbal feedback during lessons. Throughout lessons, adults will address any misconceptions that children have individually. We also provide children with learning goals to focus on in their next pieces of learning. We are beginning to use purple pen to respond to feedback and edit and improve our learning, which the children are becoming more confident with.

- 7. As a Rights Respecting School, we are promoting the rights of a child and using this within our behaviour policy. The children are becoming more familiar with their rights and are starting to understand when their behaviour is affecting this.
- 8. Within lessons, we regularly discuss the importance of friendship and what it means to be a good friend. The children use the friend bench outside when they are feeling alone and it is lovely to see other children going to help the children that are sat there at play times and lunch times.
- 9. Children in Year 2 have different responsibilities that they are trusted with. Some children are prefects and we also have classroom monitors which are changed weekly. This is to encourage responsibility and independence in the classroom.
- 15. We send out homework at the beginning of each new learning concept that is linked to the specific concept. Children seem to enjoy completing these activities, particularly the more practical activities. It is lovely when children come into class with facts that they have learnt at home linking to our learning concept. We also promote various activities that the children can do at home to support with their Maths and English Learning. Times Table Rock Stars has been a particularly popular website with the children, and it is clear to see that it is having a positive impact on their recall of times tables within their weekly around the world challenge.

## **Responses to General Comments**

"I want to read more books" – Each term we receive a box of books from the library service that is linked to our learning. The children really enjoy accessing these books as they are different to ones that we normally have. We also have a class story that we read daily and the children vote on which book they would like to read in the library. The children particularly enjoyed reading George's Marvellous Medicine which was our most recent choice.

"More music" – We are very lucky to have Mrs Gilbert teaching the children Samba weekly. The children are enjoying learning to use a wider variety of instruments and becoming more confident in their musical performances.

Thank you for completing the surveys. They do help us to evaluate all of the different aspects of your learning experience here at Windmill Hill Academy.
