Fronted Adverbials

- Fronted adverbials go at the beginning of a sentence
 - It describes the verb in the sentence
- It can describe when, where or how the verb takes place
 - Use a comma after the fronted adverbial

When

As soon as he could, he ordered his favourite pizza.





Where

On the beach, they played cricket.

In the depths of the forest, the squirrels played.

Near to the village, lived a frightening troll.

How

Enthusiastically, they danced the night away.

Nervously, they crept downstairs trying not to wake their parents.

Happily, she stroked the cat.
